BANDAGING AND RUGS ACHIEVEMENT BADGE

GUIDELINES:

To be able to put on stable bandages, a tail bandage, a stable rug and roller and a New Zealand / turnout rug.

Recommended Reading:

KEYPOINTS:

- Correctly put on stable bandage
- Correctly put on a tail bandage
- Correctly put on a roller
- Correctly put on a New Zealand rug.

TEACHING, TESTING IDEAS AND RESOURCES:

This is obviously a series of practical exercises.

Additional points could be introduced, such as the importance of not putting bandages on too tightly or too loosely; when a pony might need stable bandages, a tail bandage, etc. i.e. when travelling. (See Loading)
